



The Scottish St. Andrew Society of Greater St. Louis

The purposes of this Society are declared to be patriotic, historical, educational, cultural, charitable, and philanthropic. The Society's aims and objectives shall include aid and assistance to the worthy, including those of Scottish birth and descent, and to foster and exchange cultural, benevolent, educational and recreational ideas and pursuits between those of Scottish birth or descent and others in the Greater St. Louis Area. In the pursuits of these aims the Society shall bring the people and community of Greater St. Louis the unique benefits of our Scottish and American heritage and traditions.

The Society shall endeavor to make vital and significant contributions to the cultural and educational life of the community in the Arts and Sciences. These activities may include Achievement Awards to area schools and colleges, and other activities to perpetuate the memories, history, customs, music, literature, poetry and folklore of the Scottish and American peoples.

The Society meetings shall include the celebration of St. Andrew's Day and the birthday of Robert Burns, and friendly exchange among our members, the American people, and all other persons of Scottish descent and origin.

In carrying out these objectives and activities, the Society will be governed by the published Constitution and Bye-Laws, and be led by an elected Board of Officers.
