The St. Andrews Society's purposes, aims, and objectives are to foster and exchange cultural, benevolent, educational and recreational ideas and pursuits between those of Scottish birth or descent and others in the Greater St. Louis area.

The St. Andrews Society is keyed upon the family unit and family participation in dances, traditions and in general all events of the Society.
